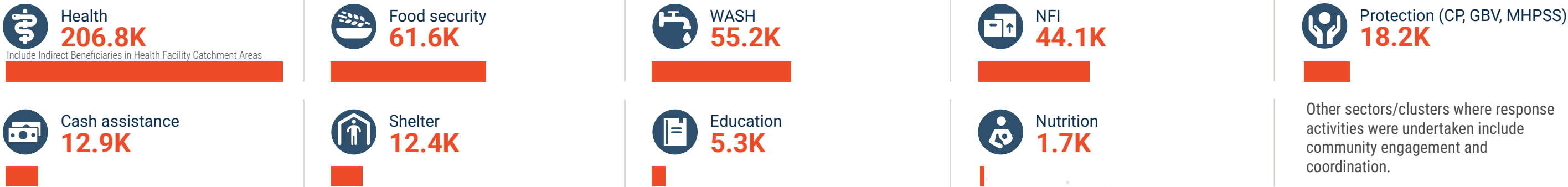


3 MONTHS RESPONSE

Over three months since the 7.8-magnitude earthquake that devastated Southern Mindanao and affected more than 1.6 million people, most communities have returned to their homes. However, more than **25,000 people remain displaced** across 73 evacuation centres, while **69,800 are temporarily staying with friends or relatives**. Significant needs among affected populations persist, and continued support for recovery efforts remains essential. The situation of displaced families has been further aggravated by heavy monsoon rains in June and July, followed by dry conditions since August.
