

On 08 June 2026, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck the Southern Mindanao, with the epicenter located 32 kilometers off the coast of Maasim, Sarangani. The earthquake brought widespread shaking across Mindanao that caused infrastructure damage including collapsed buildings and houses, roads, bridges, hospitals, schools and disrupted utilities in Region 12 and 11. One month after the earthquake, significant needs among affected populations remain, and continued support for recovery efforts is still needed.

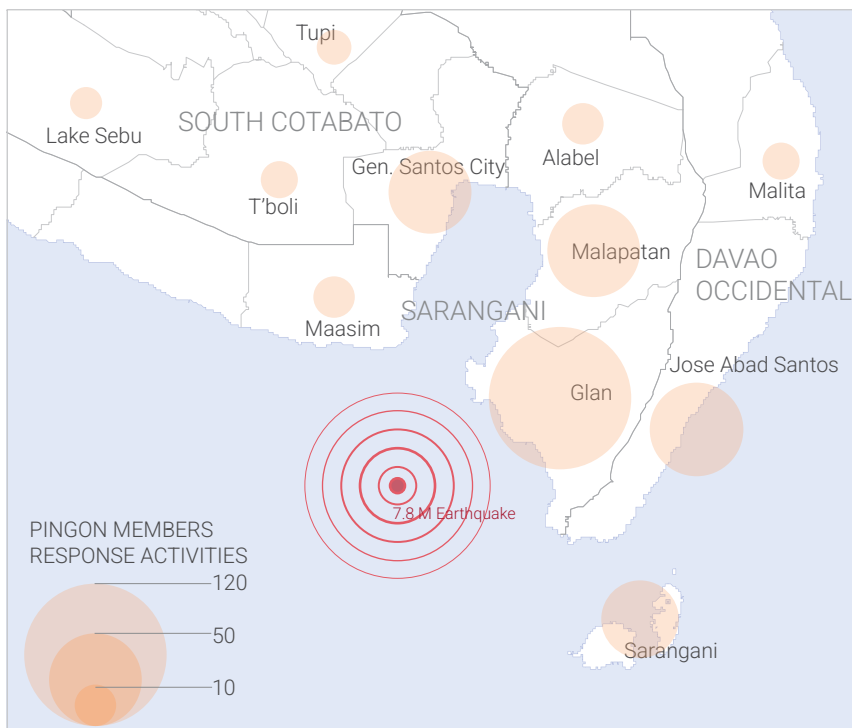

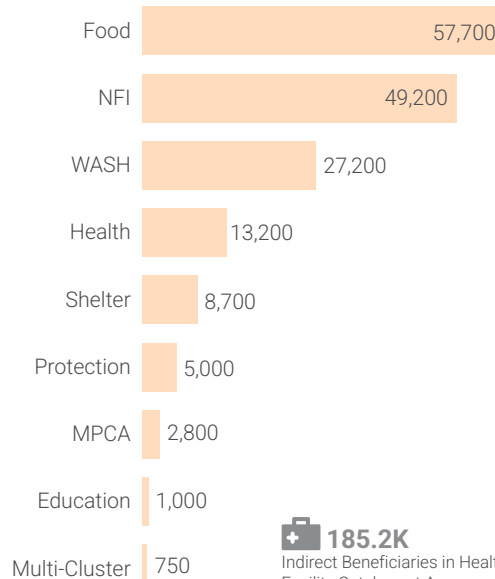

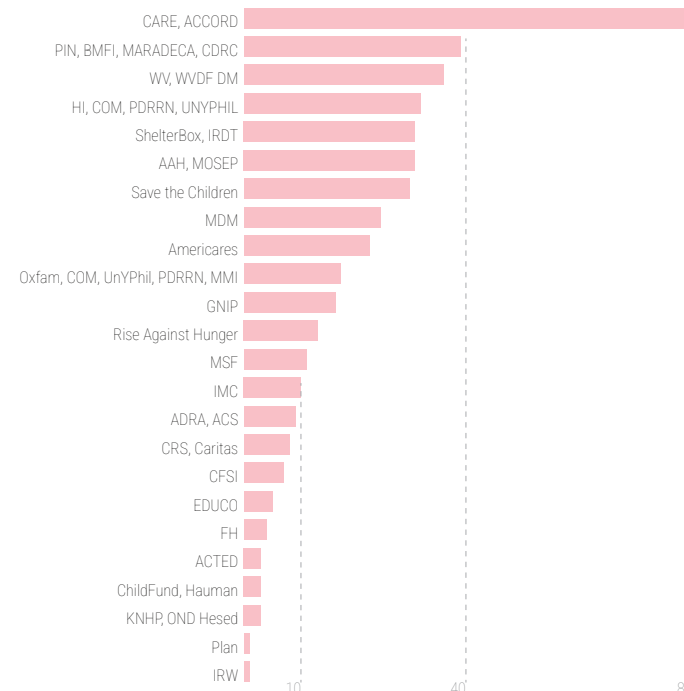
BENEFICIARIES REACHED BY SECTOR



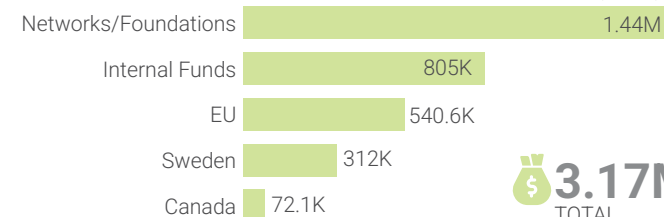
