PINGON RESPONSE SNAPSHOT (as of 10 August 2026)

More than two months after the 7.8-magnitude earthquake that severely impacted Southern Mindanao, significant needs among affected populations persist, and continued support for recovery efforts remains essential. The situation of displaced families is further aggravated by ongoing monsoon rains, which trigger flooding and landslides.

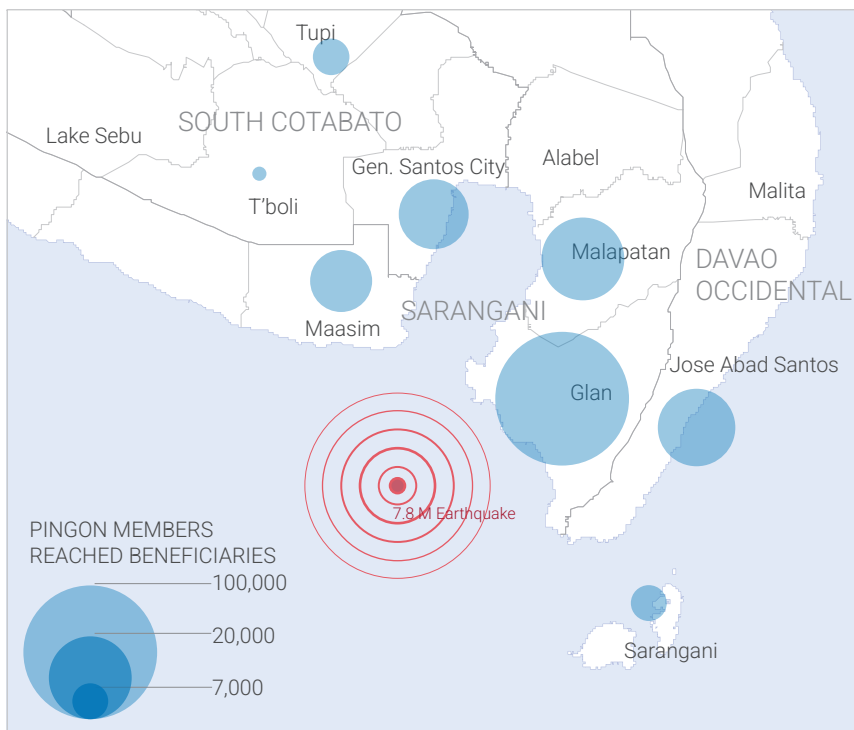

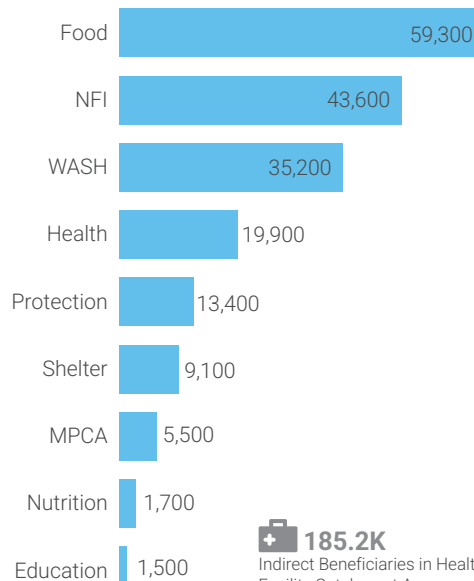

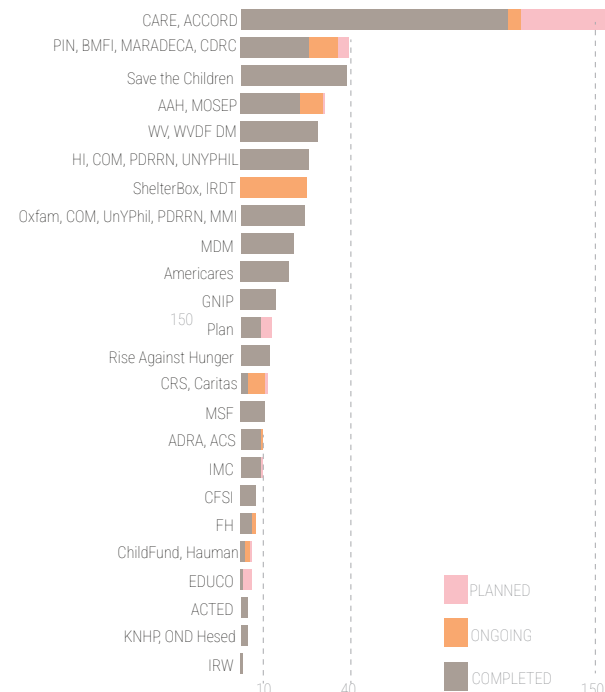

BENEFICIARIES REACHED BY SECTOR

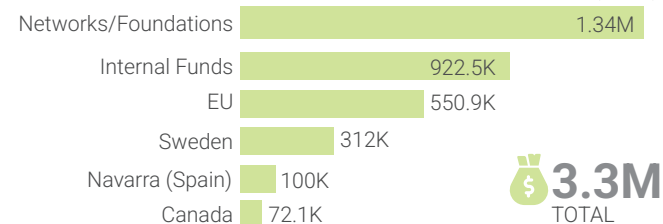
