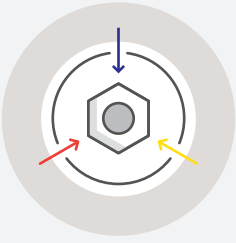




PHILIPPINE INCLUSIVE NGO NETWORK

PINGON

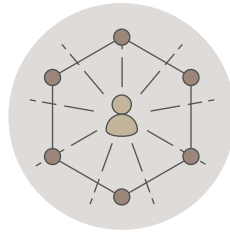


The Philippine Inclusive NGO network (PINGON) is a collaborative network of 48 international and national NGOs operating in the Philippines. It was established in 2007 as a venue to coordinate the provision and delivery of humanitarian aid by international, national, and local NGOs during times of major disasters and emergencies in the Philippines, ensuring that basic humanitarian principles are firmly upheld and minimum standards are observed. Together with their local partner organizations, PINGON maintains presence in all regions of the country.

GOALS



Strengthen collective capacity to deliver and advocate for people-centered, locally led humanitarian assistance that is coordinated, principled, and responsive to the priorities and strengths of communities in need.

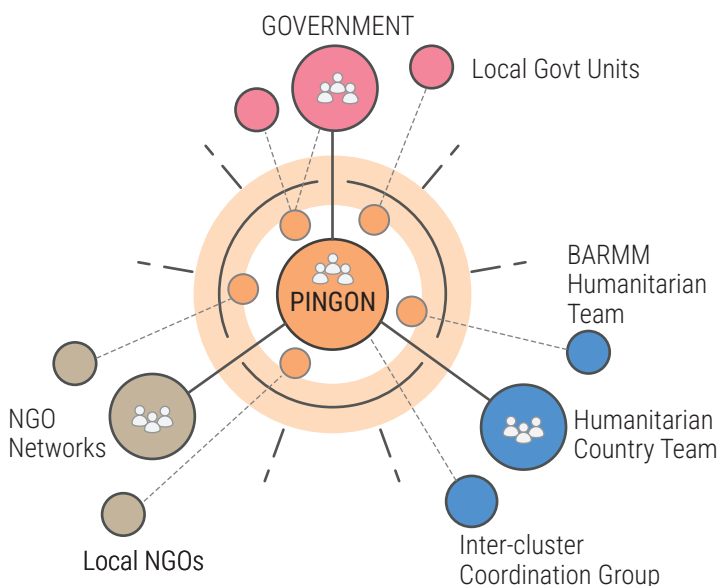


Collectively engage in humanitarian coordination, information sharing, and advocacy efforts to influence policy, resource partners, public opinion, and the practice of humanitarian action.



Practice shared commitment to localization by fostering common understanding, aligning with global standards, building solidarity with networks, and promoting direct support for national and local civil society organizations.

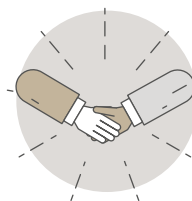
COORDINATION

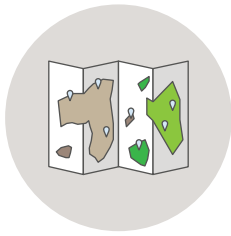

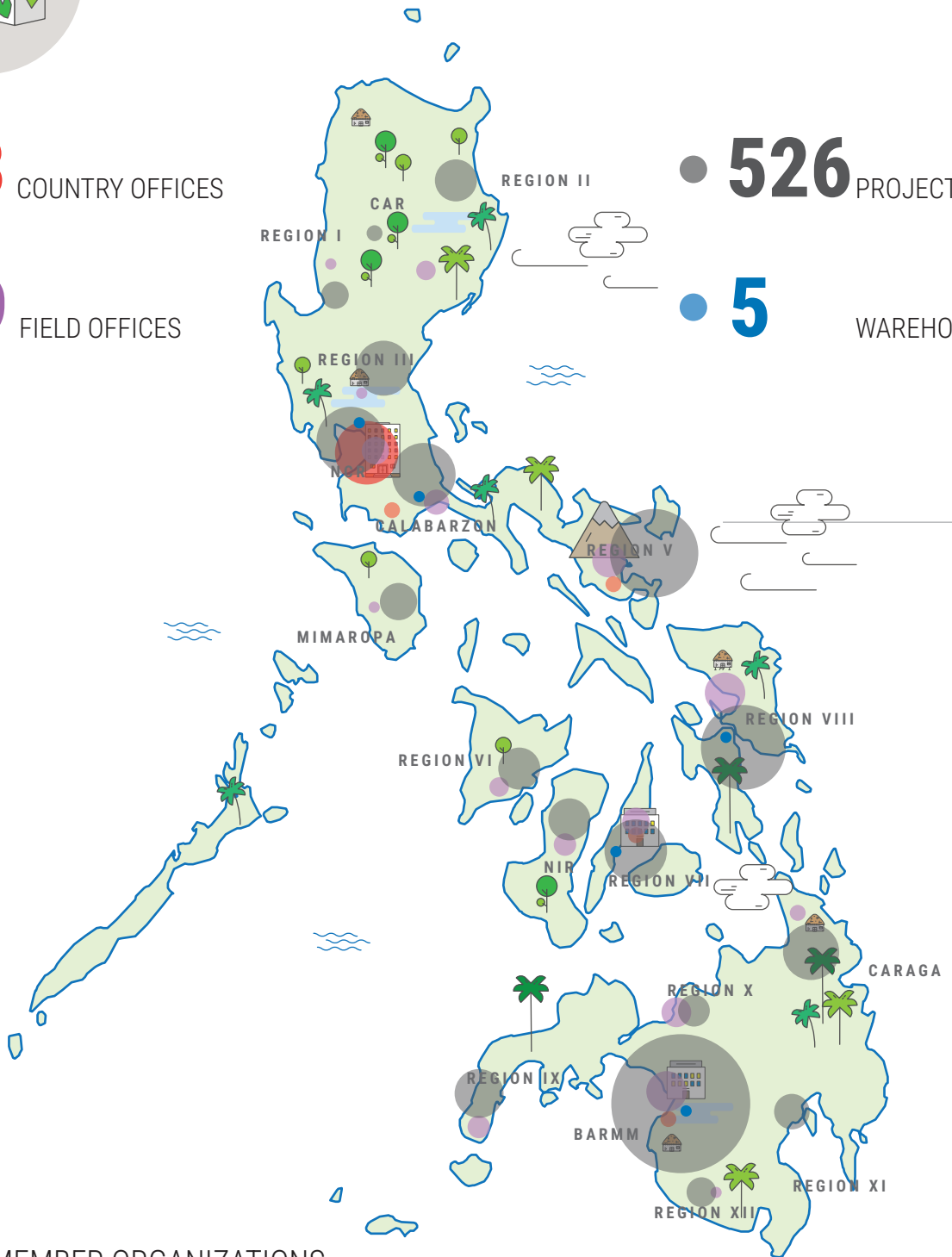
